For 2009-2010, the Assessment Committee is charged to:

1. After their syllabi collection process, meet with the Curriculum Committee to add detail to the assessment plan concerning course level learning objectives.
2. Implement the recently approved assessment plan. Develop a systematic approach to assessing outcomes to maximize value of the BS and PharmD programs and to ensure compliance with ACPE accreditation guidelines for the PharmD program.
3. In conjunction with the Academic Planning Council, develop and implement a plan for programmatic assessment in light of *Standards 2007*.
4. Conduct faculty, staff, and alumni surveys. Work with the Faculty/Staff/Student Relations Committee regarding questions about School climate for faculty and staff.
5. Explore the use of electronic portfolios in the PharmD program.
6. Explore the barriers that have surfaced in the current course/instructor/TA on-line evaluation process for each course in the BS and PharmD curricula.
7. Provide statistical data, reports, and/or other information as appropriate.
8. Ensure that committee members take responsibility for serving as a two-way conduit of information, concerns, and issues to and from the individual divisions and units.
9. Construct meeting agendas and maintain detailed minutes of Committee discussions, actions, and recommendations. In addition, provide a short, written report to the Dean by June 30, 2010 summarizing the year's activities of the Committee and how those activities support the School's mission and strategic priorities. These documents will be posted, as appropriate, on the developing *SOP Committee Activities* webpage to keep the School informed.
10. Bring items and issues forward for faculty discussion/decision making throughout the year, as appropriate. If requested by the Dean, provide a short, verbal report of the past year's Committee activities to the faculty at a Fall 2010 Faculty/Staff meeting.
